



~~ Boundary County Youth Flight Scholarship ~~

The local Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA), in 2015, will be offering up to two aviation scholarships for Boundary County youths and one for a Troy Montana youth, 16 to 18 years of age. Flight training must be at Northern Air Inc., located in Bonners Ferry Idaho. The scholarships (up to a \$2,500 'non-cash' value) will include ground school and flight training. Ground school classes are held at the Boundary County Airport Terminal building.

Requirements to be considered for these scholarships:

1. Applicants must write an autobiography that includes their birth date.
2. Applicants must write an essay explaining why they would like to learn to fly. The essay must include applicant's address and phone number.
3. Applicant's parent or guardian must write a letter explaining why their child deserves the opportunity and authorizing their child to take flight training.
4. Recommendation letters from members of the community are also encouraged.
5. The student should have a willingness to serve the community at EAA Chapter aviation functions.
