

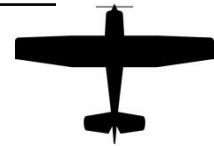

PLEASE NOTE: Factors for the total time and cost of the Private Pilot Certificate depend on previous experience, the student's ability to study, and their frequency of flight. The entire course could cost anywhere from \$7,000 to \$12,000 depending on these factors.

- Northern Air is a Part 61 Flight School, meaning the minimum requirement for flight time is 40 hours for the Private Pilot Certificate.
- The national average is 60-75 hours to get a private pilot certificate. This depends on how often you are able to fly and how quickly you learn.
- Students may use the Redbird TD2 or the Redbird FMX full motion flight simulator for a maximum of 2.5 hours of flight training towards the private pilot certificate, and for as much time and they need after the 2.5 hours to gain valuable experience at half the cost of the airplane. Simulators are especially useful for practice with emergencies and when the weather is too bad to fly.
- Plan for at least 2 additional hours of flight time for the Practical Exam.
