- Please Note: Factors for the total time and cost of the Private Pilot Certificate depend on previous experience, the student's ability to study, and their frequency of flight. The entire course could cost anywhere from \$8,000 to \$12,000 depending on these factors.
- Northern Air is a Part 61 Flight School, meaning the minimum requirement for flight time is 40 hours. The national average is 60-75 hours to get a private pilot certificate.
- Students may use the Redbird TD2 or Redbird FMX full motion flight simulator for a maximum of 2.5 hours of flight training toward the private pilot certificate, and for as much time as they need afterward to gain valuable experience at half the cost of renting the airplane. Simulators are especially useful for practice with emergencies and during bad weather.
- Plan for at least 2 additional hours of flight time for the practical exam.
